

OPCAT visit to the Children's Home for Unaccompanied Minors in the Károlyi István Child Care Centre, Fót



On 23 September 2015, the staff of the OPCAT National Preventive Mechanism (NPM) Department conducted an unannounced visit to the Children's Home for Unaccompanied Minors in the Károlyi István Child Care Centre.

The members of the visiting team, with the assistance of Arabic and Farsi interpreters, heard the unaccompanied minors residing in the children's home, interviewed the directors and the staff of the institution. Furthermore, they observed the buildings where the unaccompanied minors are accommodated. The NPM measured the premises, took photographs of the furniture and examined the relevant documents. The NPM is going to publish a report on the findings and results of the visit.
