

OPCAT inspection on a site of house arrest

On 8 February 2016, members of the National Preventive Mechanism visited a private flat designated as site of house arrest. The owner of the flat had given his consent to the visit.



The purpose of the visit was to inspect the circumstances of house arrest and the treatment of the detainee. The members of the delegation made an interview with the detainee, and inspected the documentation on the house arrest.
