

OPCAT inspection in the Bács-Kiskun County Remand Prison

On February 27-28, 2019, staff members of the Commissioner for Fundamental Rights performing the duties of the OPCAT National Preventive Mechanism paid an unannounced visit to the Bács-Kiskun County Remand Prison.



The purpose of the visit was to inspect the treatment of detainees and the conditions of detention. The members of the delegation examined the material conditions, the relevant documents, and interviewed the detainees, the management of the institute, and the staff members.
