OPCAT visit to

EMMI's (Ministry of Human Capacities) Special Children's Home Center, Primary School and Trade School

On September 4-5, 2019, the Commissioner for Fundamental Rights, acting in his capacity as the OPCAT National Preventive Mechanism, paid an unannounced visit to the Esztergom-based special children's home. The purpose of the visit was to investigate into the living conditions, development and treatment of young girls receiving special needs child protection services in the institution maintained from the central budget. As part of the visit, the staff members of the Commissioner inspected the institution, they talked to the girls living there, as well as the personnel of the children's home, and they also asked them to provide some relevant documents.
