

OPCAT follow-up visit to the Platán Integrated Care Center of Bács-Kiskun County

On October 21–22, 2019, staff members and two external experts of the OPCAT National Preventive Mechanism paid a follow-up visit to the Platán Integrated Care Center of Bács-Kiskun County.



The follow-up visit was aimed at examining the living conditions and treatment of persons with disabilities residing in the institution with a special focus on the findings of the previous visit report No. AJB-3772/2017. Members of the visiting delegation inspected the premises of the institution, conducted interviews with the personnel and the residents. The medical treatment and medication of the residents were checked by a physician, catering to the residents was inspected by an expert dietician.
