

**Presentation of Chief Physician and Head of Department Dr. Gyula Sófi with the participation of the staff members of OPCAT NPM**

At 14.00 p.m. on October 14, 2019, head of department, chief physician, forensic child psychiatrist and pediatric expert Dr. Gyula Sófi, member of the Advisory Board of the European Association for Forensic Child and Adolescent Psychiatry gave a talk entitled “The Developmental Psychiatric Aspects of Psychopathy” at the Department of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry of Heim Pál National Institute of Pediatrics (1089 Budapest, Delej utca 13-15.), in which Head of Department Dr. Gergely Fliegauf and Dr. Rita Rostás participated on behalf of our Office’s Department of the OPCAT National Preventive Mechanism.

After giving a historical background, the presenter focused on the characteristic features and types of the psychopathic personality, as well as the patient flow and treatment protocol of the hospital with a nationwide catchment area. After the presentation, the audience could ask questions, and a lively professional discussion evolved, which also touched upon the visit methodology of the OPCAT NPM.
