## **OPCAT** visit

## to the Szentendre Police Headquarters and to Home Quarantine 17 April 2020

On 17 April 2020 the Commissioner for Fundamental Rights and his colleague paid a visit to the Szentendre Police Headquarters.



The purpose of the visit was to inspect the fulfilment of the measures with regard the prevention and treatment of the coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak. The Commissioner for Fundamental Rights and his colleague inspected the daily work of the policemen responsible for the control of the observation of the rules of the "home quarantines", conducted interviews with the management and staff members of the Szentendre Police Headquarters, reviewed the relevant documents. In the course of the visit interviews had been made via telephone calls with two persons being in "home quarantines" under pandemic control.
